# What a storm it was – a Boise-Bogus Storm! **Summary of the Boise-Bogus early April 2024 Storm**



### US National Weather Service Boise Idaho

The storm over the past few days brought heavy rain, snow, cold temperatures, and thunderstorms to Boise. It also broke several records. Here's a few highlights of how unusual this pattern was!



# Storm for the Record Books in Boise

The storm April 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> was extremely unusual for Boise and broke several records or was otherwise notable:

### Precipitation:

- 2.26" total.
- 1.09" on the 4th, 1.05" on the 5th broke daily records.
- · Only second time Boise has ever had 1 inch or more of rainfall on consecutive days.
- Wettest start to year on record through April 5th with 8.76" total.

### Snow:

- · 2.1 inches on April 5th broke daily record.
- · Last April day with >2" snow was in 1969.
- · Snow broke tree branches in parts of Boise.

### Temperatures:

- High of 39 degrees on April 5th was the coldest April high since 1936.
- High was 70 degrees on April 3rd.


### Thunderstorms:

- · Thunderstorms were observed on April 3rd and 4th.
- Storms on April 3<sup>rd</sup> brought dime to quarter size hail.




- Back-to-back days with 1 inch of precipitation while other areas didn't receive nearly as much.
- PRISM summary below uses all available data, while Days > 1" is probably just based on valley NWS data.

Maybe some day soon, we'll be able to analysis all data together with the same tools...




Precipitation # Days > 1.00" 3/30/2024 - 4/12/2024




# While the valley received moisture for only a few days, the storm remained over Bogus bring more snow and thick clouds that made skiing fun but challenging to see.







- Van Wyck received 1.7" which is 100% of its monthly total.





